During the 2023 legislative session, as part of the biennial state budget for fiscal years 2024 and 2025, the General Assembly passed a cap on the per-student tuition amount AgriScience program operators, as well as magnet school operators, may charge local or regional school districts that send students to attend these school choice options.

Beginning in fiscal year 2025, the per-student tuition amount an operator of an AgriScience program or a magnet school (either a Regional Educational Service Center (RESC) or a local or regional board of education (BOE)) may charge is capped at 58% of the per-student tuition amount the operator charged in FY 2024. As a result of this cap, sending districts paying tuition for students who attend AgriScience programs or magnet schools will experience savings due to lower tuition costs.

Districts are estimated to save a combined \$39.1 million in tuition costs in FY 2025 as a result of the cap. Approximately \$29.3 million (75%) of the total savings will be realized by Alliance Districts — the state's lowest-performing districts.

The estimated savings in FY 2025 for each town as a result of the 58% tuition cap are listed in the table below.
