UNDERFUNDED SCHEDULE

Annual increases until full funding is reached:

- FY 19 FY 24: Town receives annual increases
- FY 25 and FY 26: Town receives larger increases, reaching full funding in FY 26
- FY 27 FY 32: Full funding continues

OVERFUNDED SCHEDULE

Decreases or hold harmless, depending on year, until at full funding:

- FY 19 FY 21: Town receives annual decreases
- FY 22 FY 25: No losses from prior FY (i.e., hold harmless)
- FY 26 FY 32: Town loses approximately the same amount each year, reaching full funding in FY 32

ALLIANCE DISTRICTS

BOTH OVERFUNDED AND UNDERFUNDED ALLIANCE DISTRICTS RECEIVE THE GREATER OF:

- 1. Their FY 17 grant
- 2. Their prior year grant
- 3. The grant they receive using the method described above

DATA UPDATES

- THE FULLY FUNDED AMOUNT CHANGES ANNUALLY TO REFLECT UPDATED STUDENT AND TOWN DATA
- TOWNS CAN SWITCH BETWEEN OVERFUNDED IN ONE YEAR TO UNDERFUNDED IN THE NEXT, AND VICE VERSA, DEPENDING ON CHANGES IN STUDENT AND TOWN DATA

IN FY 32, THE FORMULA IS FULLY PHASED-IN.
NO TOWN IS OVER- OR UNDER-FUNDED.
